Welcome word of president



The Air Tahiti Nui challenge has become an unmissable event in French Polynesia. Since 2021, we have made this event an opportunity to promote and share the values of Polynesian judo, by inviting American, Canadian, Swiss and French teams.

Because we are attached to the sense of hospitality as much as to the principle of mutual aid and prosperity, we are committed to building lasting bonds of friendship with the delegations we invite to discover our culture as well as to contribute to the progress and development of each of the participants.

It is the concept of this tournament to invite delegations served by the ATN company, in order to offer them a sporting, friendly, cultural and tourist experience. This is the spirit that we convey during the "friendly challenge" by mixed teams, but also by organizing the visit of Moorea, during a day of excursion at a preferential rate.

This welcome word is an opportunity to thank the IJSPF for its decisive financial and logistical support. I would also like to thank the ATN company of course, but also the Judo Club Pontault Combault who received us during the Coupe de France minimes in March 2022, the province of Vancouver and the Seattle club, which we met again in October 2022 for two training camps and two selective competitions for the 2023 Pacific Games, the major objective of this year and of our end of mandate. We hope that the 2024 edition will be an opportunity to welcome countries from the Pacific zone such as New Caledonia or New Zealand.

The ATN challenge is also a training camp supervised by great champions. In 2021 and 2023, we welcomed Matthieu Bataille, triple world medallist, French representative at the Athens Olympic Games as a fighter and then at the Tokyo Games as a referee.

In 2021, we also welcomed Clarisse Agbegnenou, six-time World Champion, individual and team Olympic champion. The following year, it was Darcel Yandzi, 7th DAN, European champion and bronze medalist at the 1993 World Championship who led the course. They were keen to share their experience of high-level sport with Polynesian and foreign judokas.

For this 4th edition, we have chosen a world star from Japan, in the person of Joshiro Maruyama, 2 times World Champion in 2019 and 2021.

We hope that every fighter will be able to experience an exceptional moment, in the heart of the Pacific Ocean.

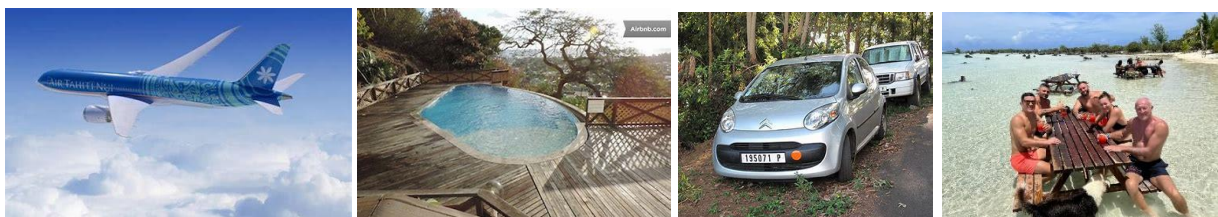

« Maeva » pack for foreign delegations

To facilitate the participation of foreign delegations, the FPJ offers a "maeva" pack for each one (minimum 7 fighters and 1 coach), which includes offers for:

- **Travel to Tahiti**
 - The Polynesian Judo Federation is booking the flight with the airline Air Tahiti Nui, at a preferential rate departing from Paris, Los Angeles, Seattle or Auckland, from December 7 to 17
 - Free air ticket for the head coach of the delegation (minimum 7 fighters)
- **Accommodation (your choice):**
 - Free accommodation at the Institut Jeunesse et Sport de Polynésie Française between 7 and 17 December (offer limited to 40 participants*)
 - Accommodation in an Air'BnB with a contribution to the costs from the FPJ of €10 per day and per person, between 7 and 17 December (offer limited to 10 participants*, reservation at the expense of the delegation)
- **Transport :**
 - The possibility between 7 and 17 December to rent vehicles at a preferential rate, with a contribution to the costs from the FPJ of €10 per day and per vehicle (4 people per vehicle) and €20 per day for a minibus (8 people minimum)
- **Tourist activities :**
 - The visit of Moorea on December 15 or 16, for a preferential rate of 68€ per person (Ferry, encounter with rays and sharks, introduction to traditional meal activities)
 - Putting you in touch with local service providers to participate in other visits (Diving, The ferry, the island of Tetiaroa)



*Judokas and their coach are considered to be participants. Delegations may be accompanied by other people who will be able to benefit from our offers on flights and on the guided tour of Moorea, but who will not benefit from the offers on accommodation and transport

- Age and weight categories may change depending on Polynesian and foreign participants. The objective is not to go on a diet to reach a weight category but to offer as many fights as possible while respecting the physical and moral integrity of each participant.
- U14s are allowed to fight in U17 and U17s are allowed to fight in Elite

Training Camp



The FPJ is organizing a free training camp open to all tournament participants and all Polynesian licensees born in 2013 and before, from December 12 to 14, 2024. It will take place on the basis of one training session per day and some activities allowing our guests to discover Tahiti.

After Clarisse Agbegnenou in 2021 (Five-time World Champion and Olympic Champion), Mathieu Bataille in 2021 and 2023 (triple bronze medallist at the World Championship and Olympic athlete in 2004, then Olympic referee in 2020) and Darcel Yandzi in 2022 (7th Dan, European Champion and world medalist in 1993), this course will be led by Joshiro Maruyama (2019 and 2021 World Champion).

During this training camp, the FPJ also organize a visit of Moorea (68€ per person). This tour includes the round trip ferry crossing, the encounter with rays and sharks, the introduction to traditional activities (dancing and weaving) and the traditional meal with drinks included.
